E-Entrance

1. Start of Lake Trail Banana Run Canal (BRC)
2. First intersection on Lake Trail on BRC
3. Mid-way Lake Trail on BRC \*
4. Foot Bridge over Banana Lake
5. Begin upper trail to the Lake
6. Mid-way Upper Trail to the Lake
7. End Upper trail at the Lake
8. Start of Sanctuary Trail near the Picnic Pavilion
9. Mid-Sanctuary Trail
10. End of Sanctuary Trail at Ridge Trail

11. Split to left Begin Banana Lake Trail
  12. First right turn Banana Lake Trail
  13. Banana Lake Trail
  14. Banana Lake Midway
  15. Banana Lake End turn right
  16. onto Stahl Canal Trail
  17. Continue on Coyote Trail
  18. Clubhouse Trail Exit to Golf Course (tends to flood)
  19. Low trail to Garden
  20. Butterfly & Bird Garden 
  21. Compost Pile
  22. Exit Trail system
- Over footbridge by lake two finger trails varied aquatic wildlife no outlet- Eagle Overlook
