NEW INFORMATION ABOUT CABLE SYSTEM

All guests and seasonal residents

If you have scanned all the 62 channels in and all of a sudden you lose one or more please do not rescan. Call the RV Office 863-665-1726, during business hours or if it is after hours call the Ranger, 863-665-3028 on duty so he can check our equipment at the server. If you rescan it will eliminate the channel from your line up. And once the maintenance or Ranger resets the server you will have to rescan again. So save yourself some time and don't rescan just report the channel loss.

The new cable system has been instituted in the park & many sets have picked up all 62 channels after searching them out. There are some issues with some new RV owners who have monitor television sets not TVs with tuners. Please contact the office if you are having an issue picking up all the cable channels. We are also aware of some individual park models that are going to require new installations since they never used the cable service before or their wiring is not in good shape, a list has been provided to Spectrum. Again, we are awaiting Spectrum for when these items will be installed and fixed.

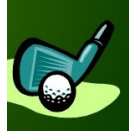
Sanlan Golf Course — DRIVING RANGE

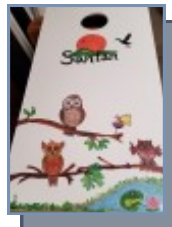
